Publikationsfonds by Land Schleswig-Holstein: Funding up to 2000 Euro is possible if the submitting or corresponding author is a junior scientist who has graduated within the last 10 years, the journal is an entirely Open Access –not a hybrid– journal, and the publisher is not Springer, Elsevier or Wiley (funding is limited)
